Candidates who download the tender document must forward their particulars immediately to samburu.proc@kerra.go.ke to facilitate any further clarification or addendums.
4. All Tenders for special groups (AGPO) must be accompanied by a **"Tender-Securing Declaration"**

6. There shall be no Pre-Tender site meeting. However, site visit is MANDATORY and Bidders are required to plan their own visit to the site and thereafter obtain a duly signed Site Visit Certificate from Authorized Regional Officer as indicated in the Instruction to Bidders. Upon proof of the visit.
